### Results of the Special Interclub Judging

At the March meeting, we enjoyed several makers' various interpretations of each other's works. It is amazing how creative we can be.

The whole club also viewed and judged digital images from New Haven Camera Club. Unfortunately, the digital projector in use at the time with its settings did not prove to be conducive to the best viewing. I found that the scores varied wildly compared to what usually happens with a more controlled three judge panel, using 4-9. The scoring was base on 10-30, and the range varied as much as 12 points for the same image. Surprisingly, when I averaged the scores, they were mostly in line with my previous judging results (on my own monitor).
